Pentecost Sunday





From the Desk of Fr. Paul:

Pentecost marks 50 days after Easter and concludes the Easter season. It commemorates the fulfillment of Jesus's promise to send an Advocate

to be with us, allowing us to know Christ's presence even now. This Advocate is the Holy Spirit. The Spirit arrived at Pentecost quite unexpectedly but very definitively! Pentecost marks the beginning of the Church.

Many people from the known Mediterranean world had gathered in Jerusalem for the feast. The arrival of the Spirit was experiential yet also mystical, even beyond what words can adequately describe. The description in the Acts of the Apostles states the experience of the Holy Spirit was under the appearance of tongues of fire and the sound of a rushing wind! Very strange indeed. People began to understand languages they had never understood before. The gift of the Spirit unifies humanity and comes with a Great Commission to the Church to make disciples of all nations - this was Jesus's command we heard last week on the Feast of the Ascension. The Holy Spirit empowers this mission, making it effective. The Spirit does not abandon us but is working in our world and in the Church in a multitude of expressions, even now.

The **Compendium of the Cathechism of the Catholic Church** describes the significance of Pentecost this way:

"Fifty days after the Resurrection at Pentecost the glorified Jesus Christ poured out the Spirit in abundance and revealed him as a divine Person so that the Holy Trinity was fully manifest. The mission of Christ and of the Spirit became the mission of the Church which is sent to proclaim and spread the mystery of the communion of the Holy Trinity."

"We have seen the true Light, we have received the heavenly Spirit, we have found the true faith: we adore the indivisible Trinity, who has saved us." (Byzantine Liturgy, Troparion of Vespers of Pentecost)
