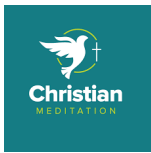

Towards Healing and Atonement: March 23

In recent months Archbishop Mancini has shared his concerned for all who have been hurt by the sexual abuse, both victims and all who have been scandalized by this evil. In response, he is inviting interested members of the faithful to join him on Saturday, March 23 at the Atlantic School of Theology. This will be a day to reflect on and discuss how we can start to heal in the midst of the Church's sexual abuse crisis. Archbishop Mancini has put this invitation forward in a pastoral letter that in part reads:

"In our diocese, I am concerned for all those who have been hurt by the evil of sexual abuse. This most certainly refers to the victims/survivors of clerical sexual abuse. It also refers to everyone else who have been scandalized; who have felt shame and anger and who have turned away from the Church.

Out of this concern comes the desire to, at least, take a few steps towards healing for all who wish to do so. I am, therefore, inviting you to a day of conversation, reflection and dialogue, which has been called – Towards Healing and Atonement. It will take place March 23, 2019 in the chapel at the Atlantic School of Theology.

The primary purpose of this day is to promote healing in our Church. This event will provide a safe, Christ centered environment where the faithful can listen to each other, understand the harm of sexual abuse and explore the pain that is being endured by individual victims, families of victims and offenders; parishioners and the entire diocese."

Further information on how to take part in the day will be available shortly.
